- Swing sets—must be dismantled
- Box springs
- Mattresses
- Bed frames
- Gas grills—no tanks
- Charcoal grills
- Small lawn mowers or snowblowers—gas and oil must be removed

# NOT Acceptable Items!

- Electronic waste
- Yard waste
- Building materials
- Tires
- Pianos
- Lead acid batteries
- 55-gallon drums
- Household pesticides
- Concrete or dirt
- Oil tanks and filters
- Vehicle engine blocks
- Paints and thinners
- Televisions, computers and computer monitors
- Household appliances—stoves, ovens, dishwashers, freezers, microwaves, refrigerators, dryers, washers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, water softeners, or water heaters
