Stream Monitors Needed

Join a group of student water action volunteers (WAV) to study the health of Six Mile Creek. Monitors are trained to measure six elements of stream health. Get together once a month from April to October, under the guidance of the Village's program coordinator. The data will be entered into a DNR online database.

Participants will become familiar with the water quality and aquatic life in the Six Mile Creek, collect valuable data, and connect with the natural world. Insufficient data represents a major hurdle to making informed decisions. Stream monitoring provides important data that may be the only data available for a particular waterbody – you can make a difference!
