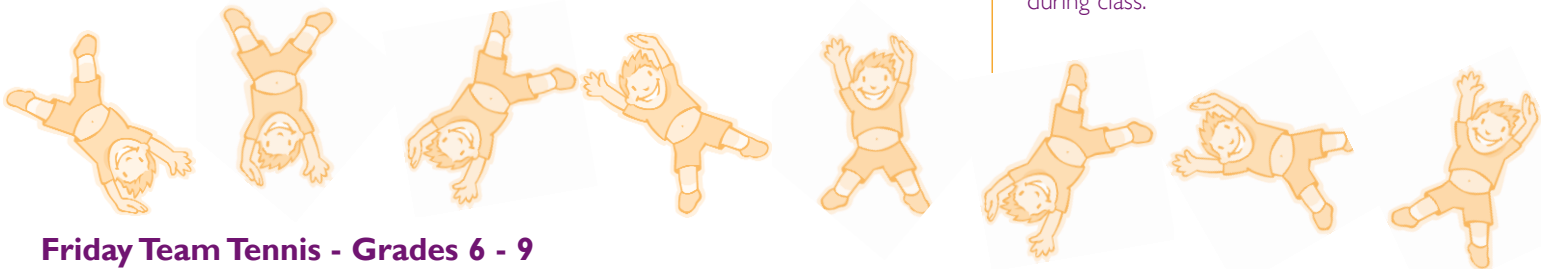

**Tumble Bugs w/parent** - Tumble Bugs is a preschool gymnastics program. Come explore landscapes, sing songs, play silly games with the parachute and much more. Kids 18 months to 4 years old, work on fine and gross motor skills with an emphasis on coordination, strength, balance and socialization, through the use of fun and kid friendly gymnastics equipment.

This parent participation class is a wonderful first step for any youngster.

**Leapin Lizards** - This class is for children who are comfortable without their parents participating, and between the ages of 3 to 6 years old. For children younger than 3 years 3 months one session of Tumble Bugs is HIGHLY recommended. **Rock N Rollers** - Come discover the foundations of gymnastics as a Rock N Roller. This Kindergarten through 5th grade class is for participants who are between the ages of 5 1/2 to 12 years old. Handstands, cartwheels, bridges, bars, beam, vault and floor exercises are just a few of the fun skills that are included in these lessons. This class emphasizes both independent and group work. 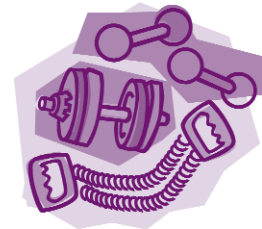
