

Waunakee PD Looking for Pharmacy Robbery Suspect

Waunakee police are looking for a man who stole drugs from a Walgreens Pharmacy on Tuesday January 15, 2013. It happened around 3:30 p.m. in the 400-block of West Main Street in Waunakee. Police say a white man in his late 20's demanded pills. There was no weapon involved. The suspect fled with an undisclosed amount of those pills.

Town of Westport Thefts and Burglaries Continue

The Town of Westport has had numerous thefts from motor vehicles and open garages in the past few months. These are mostly occurring to victims whom are forgetting to lock their vehicles and garage doors overnight. PLEASE take the time to check your vehicle and garage doors to make sure they are locked in the evening. Also remember to hide any valuables in the trunk or take them into your residence. These tips sound very simple, but if everyone would take time to do this it would prevent a lot of the crimes from occurring. And remember to report any suspicious people or vehicles to law enforcement. If possible try to get a license plate and vehicle description of any suspicious vehicles you observe.

Waunakee Police Department TIP Line

The Waunakee Police Department maintains an anonymous tips line, 849-2TIP (2847). Callers can leave a message about criminal activity including drug information. The caller may report the information they have and can remain completely anonymous. Tipsters may be eligible for a cash reward if the information results in arrest.

Callers should provide the date and time of their call, as this will become your identifying number. For example, if you call on January 1, 2013, at 10:30 your ID number would be 010120131030. If callers do want to obtain a reward they must follow up with the Tip Line coordinator, Lt. Joe Peterson at 850-4510. You will only be asked to provide your identifying number. From there, arrangements will be made to pick up the reward at a specific location.

If you are calling about a crime in progress, call 911. If it is NOT an emergency but would either like to speak with an officer or have an officer respond, please call the non-emergency number at 849-4523.
