Vietnam: February 28, 1961 - May 7, 1975

- **Served anywhere during this time in the US military**
- **Served on Active Duty or in the Reserves or National Guard**

From its inaugural flight in April 2010, Badger Honor Flight has flown over 2,000 war era Veterans to Washington DC to see the monuments built in their honor.

Part of the nationwide Honor Flight Network, Badger Honor Flight started by taking WWII Veterans and since has expanded to the war era Veterans from the Korean and Vietnam wars.

The one-day trip includes a chartered air flight from the Dane County Regional Airport and a daylong tour of all the memorials honoring the men and women who served in WWII, Korea, and Vietnam. We also make stops at the Marine and Lincoln Memorials. This FREE trip for the Veterans is our way of saying thank you for the sacrifices that those generations made for this country.

We travel from site to site on deluxe motor coaches and we supply ample food and drink during the day. We can accommodate almost any infirmity or frailty that our Veterans may have. We are staffed with expert volunteer medical staff in an effort to make it a safe and comfortable day for our honorees. We have on board 75 wheelchairs and people to assist you along the way. Throughout the day each Veteran is accompanied by a guardian. Provided the guardian meets the qualifications as listed on our website, they are often a family member or friend. If a Veteran does not have a guardian, we have DC-based volunteers who step in for that honor. The guardians pay a \$500 fee for the privilege of escorting their Veteran.

Our "normal" flight leaves Madison at 7:00 AM Saturday and lands back in Madison about 9:30 PM that night.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO KNOW THAT YOU QUALIFY FOR THIS FLIGHT IF YOU SERVED IN ANY BRANCH AND COMPONENT OF THE MILITARY DURING THE FOLLOWING DATES:

World War II: December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946

Korean War: June 25, 1950 – January 31, 1955

Vietnam War: February 28, 1961 – May 7, 1975

We understand that some of our Veterans feel they do not deserve to go because they weren't in harms way, however, you still served your country. You didn't write your orders, and deserve to be honored. If not for what you did, then for what you were willing to do.
