

2017 Construction Projects Update...for the Week of September 11th

Village of Waunakee Improvement Projects

- **2017 Public Works Improvement Projects - Century Avenue from Second Street to Woodland Drive**

The work is substantially complete, and the Century Avenue was open to traffic on September 1st.

Mill and Overlay Project

As part of the 2017 Street Improvements the Village will be resurfacing the following streets:

**Knightsbridge Road from Winston Way to South Street
Kingston Way from Knightsbridge Road to South Street
O'Malley Street from Sixth Street to Eighth Street**

The work on Knightsbridge Road is scheduled to be on Friday, September 8th, and is anticipated to take approximately 1 week to complete, weather permitting.

The work on Kingston Way and O'Malley Street will begin as the work on Knightsbridge Road is completed, and the street has been re-opened to traffic.

In order to accommodate the construction activities, these streets will be closed to thru traffic throughout the construction process. The street will be posted with a "No Parking" restriction from 7am to 7pm, Monday thru Friday. Residents within the construction zone will have access to driveways, however you may experience short periods of time when vehicle access to your property may not be possible. **Please be aware that travel within the construction zone will be at your own risk.**
