ENTRY - Enter the Centennial Park east parking lot from Holiday Drive. Look for the signs.

PARADE - The parade starts at 11:00 a.m. and usually lasts approximately an hour and a half. Many of the people that watch the parade will be going to the park after the parade is over. It gets very crowded with vehicles and pedestrian traffic at the park at the conclusion of the parade. If possible, you may want to get your show vehicle in the designated area before the first units in the parade reach Centennial Park.
